This draw will take place at 12pm (AEDT) on 31/03/2023 at TLA Melbourne, Level 3, 510 Church Street, Richmond, VIC 3122.
	If a winning Football Club no longer wishes to receive the prize at any time shortly before or after the Draw takes place, the Promoter may allocate a Reserve Football Club to take that club's place. Draft selection of ex AFL players will take place on the day/time as specified by the Promoter.
